Missouri's electric cooperatives have a long and proud history of professionalism and service. Our mission is to continue that record in the future.

The legislative staff of the Association of Missouri Electric Cooperatives represents the interests of Missouri's non-profit, member-owned rural electric cooperatives and their members before the General Assembly as well as state and local government. We are here to serve you when you need accurate, reliable and up-to-date information about Missouri's electric cooperatives, or the electric utility industry.

Missouri is served by 40 member-oriented electric distribution cooperatives. Together, these locally owned cooperatives serve nearly 800,784 meters at homes, businesses and farms in rural Missouri. We operate in every rural county and are leaders in community progress and economic development.

Furthermore, Missouri's electric cooperatives have built a network of transmission cooperatives that provide

access to wholesale power that few states enjoy. The third element in Missouri's three-tiered electric cooperative system is Associated Electric Cooperative. Our generation cooperative is one of the lowest-cost power providers in America.

Because Missouri's electric cooperatives are grassroots organizations, supervised by people who use the services the co-ops provide, you can be assured that our systems operate with the interest of consumers in mind. Each of our cooperatives is governed by a board of directors elected by the membership.

These member-directors set policies that affect not only their neighbors, but also their own utility service. This model of citizen-consumer governance has continued to ensure the electric cooperatives provide low-cost and reliable electricity service to the state's rural


residents for more than three-quarters of a century.

Our Proud History



In the 1930s, rural people lived lifestyles similar to that of their pioneer ancestors. Their children suffered while trying to do homework by the feeble light of lanterns.

Without “luxuries” like indoor plumbing and refrigeration, the bright lights of the cities lured away the best and brightest rural youth.

In 1935, the Rural Electrification Administration, or REA, was established. Its purpose was to make low-cost loans available to bring rural America out of the darkness. At first it was believed that private power companies already in existence would use these REA funds to extend their lines into the countryside. This did not happen because the low density of rural areas would not allow the private power companies to make sufficient profit.

Instead, the farmers and other rural people took matters into their own hands and used the cooperative business model to form more than 1,000 rural electric cooperatives. Through determination, dedication and hard work, electric cooperatives

have overcome every obstacle placed in their paths. When power supply became an issue they built their own power plants. When transmission did not meet their needs they built their own. When ice storms, tornadoes, hurricanes and floods brought down the lines they worked together to rebuild.


Over the years, electric cooperatives have served as a catalyst for the revitalization of America’s rural communities. They began by making rural businesses possible and continue to work directly to promote rural areas as good places in which to do business. Today electric cooperatives can be found behind nearly every economic development project that has the potential to provide jobs for members; however, they are not content to rest on past successes.

Electric cooperatives continue to raise the standard of living for their members by offering broadband internet and other services vital to the success of rural communities.

The Cooperative Difference

Our Three-Tiered System

Missouri's electric cooperative network is organized into three tiers, each with a distinct responsibility.

At the top are 40 local distribution cooperatives that provide electric service directly to consumer-members, including businesses, farms and households.

At the second level of the system are the six regional generation and transmission (or G&T) cooperatives that transmit power from the generators to the distribution systems

In 1961, the six G&Ts joined together to form Associated Electric Cooperative, Inc., the system's third tier. AECI takes care of generation, power procurement and high-voltage transmission. Over the years, AECI has built a diverse generating portfolio and strong, integrated transmission system which provides economical and reliable power to transmission and distribution cooperatives in Missouri as well as parts of Iowa and Oklahoma.

This three-tiered system is unique to Missouri's electric cooperatives and provides an excellent structure to keep rates low and service reliable.

Tying the three tiers of Missouri's electric cooperative system together is the Association of Missouri Electric Cooperatives (AMEC). AMEC is a statewide organization based in Jefferson City. Since its founding in 1937, AMEC has been the voice of the 40 electric distribution cooperatives and seven generation and transmission systems in the state which provide electric service to almost 800,784 meters at homes, businesses and farms representing more than 2 million Missourians.

Each department within AMEC — legislative and government relations, member services, internal operations, risk management & training, and communications — works closely with our local cooperative systems. Our mission is to provide a means for electric cooperatives to accomplish goals collectively that they could not do as effectively on their own.

Each of the cooperatives in the non-profit rural electric system is owned by the members it serves and operates under the guidance of a board of directors elected by the membership. Likewise, AMEC is non-profit, member-owned and controlled by a board of its member systems. By working together, and focusing on member needs, cooperatives continue sustainable development of rural communities. That's the cooperative way of doing business.



Powering Rural Missouri


Balanced, Diverse Generation Benefits Members



CAPITOL FLOOR PLAN


